# Sailing School Re-Imagined

As you may already know, the COVID19 pandemic resulted in significant changes to our summer sailing program last year, including a drastically scaled back program to ensure the safety of our students, their families, and our staff.

This year, while continuing to follow the State of New Hampshire's, *Safer at Home – Day Camps Guide*, we have brought back safety features from last year to meet those guidelines and enhanced them to make sailing school feel a little more normal.

This season we will include:

- Level 1, 2, 3, and mighty mini classes as well as some new, and improved, racing classes.
- Larger class sizes.
- Our classrooms will still be in the great outdoors only.
- Full day classes are back, 5 days a week!
- We will continue staggered start times to reduce congestion in the yard.
- Students will be paired in boats if approved by parents/guardian. You can
  - o pick a partner
  - o have a partner selected for you
  - o or chose to sail solo (Optis and O'Pen Bics only).
- Classes may be canceled in the event of inclement weather that would require the students to stay indoors. Our buildings will still be closed to students.
- We will have several large tents on site in case shelter is needed.
- Masks will still be required while on shore.

We are very excited to introduce our new Cohort Program for the coming season. For 2021, following a similar successful policy instituted at the Gunstock Ski Club, we are implementing a practice which will allow our kids to sail in cohorts, or pairs. This will enable us to teach beginners, have a proper race program, and to pair students up in the 420 sailboats. This will not only make for a safe program for all concerned but will greatly enhance the sailing school experience. It will work as follows:

- Parents must approve in writing that their child can sail with another designated child with the following options:
  - o The parent will designate the partner.
  - o The LWSA will assign a partner.
  - o The parent will state that the child must sail alone
- These student pairings will be effective for the entire week(s).
- When on the grounds and in classroom setting, they will adhere to all of the School's COVID rules and policies.
- When rigging and de-rigging they will wear their masks, but social distancing between the two cohorts will not be required.
- When on the water
  - o There will be no masks worn in the dinghies for safety concerns.

- Masks will be worn at all times in the keelboats.
- While our primary goal will always be prevention, this arrangement will aid in facilitating contact tracing if required.

The PHRF fleet will be holding the traditional events sponsored by the LWSA including the Spring into Summer Regatta on June 12, and the Labor Day weekend events including the Frying Pan double handed race on September 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Labor Day Weekend Regatta on September 4<sup>th</sup>. Also do not forget the great events put on by the Winnipesaukee Yacht Club including the JBT Race and Auction on July 17, the WYC Commodore's Cup on August 13, 14 and 15 as well as the WYC Cold Duck Race to end the season on October 10.

Finally, Al Posnack has organized an exciting series of racing seminars this spring with renowned expert on the Racing Rules of Sailing Dave Perry.

Dave is well known for his enthusiastic and engaging teaching style for sailors of all ages and levels, as well as highly respected for his deep knowledge of the sport of Sailing. He is one of the sport's leading rules experts, serving on the US Sailing Appeals Committee and being the Rules Advisor for several recent America's Cup teams and the US Sailing Team at the 2008, 2012 and 2021 Olympic Games. Dave has learned how to bring his same engaging and effective teaching style to the Zoom platform and is excited to work with the sailors and race officials on Lake Winnipesaukee to know the rules better so they are more confident in close-quarter action at the starts and around the marks, and so they can play and run the game at a higher level. Dave encourages sailors who normally crew to join us because knowing the rules better will dramatically increase their racing enjoyment.
